Title and number each page of your play.

Submissions cannot have been previously performed.

Plays must be postmarked no later than March 31st

Guidelines for a winning script

Family Oriented Material

Vocabulary, language and subject matter should be written with young children and senior citizens in mind.

Laboratory Theater Production

Simple set designs work best, as does limiting the number of scene changes and props required.

Other Constraints

One act plays should be longer than fifteen minutes and shorter than forty-five minutes.

Plays with many characters are difficult to cast.

Selected plays will be performed at our *Summer Lab Theatre* in August.
